Guidelines for Applications

Christ Church Cathedral Mission Statement

Our mission is to be an inclusive community of caring Christians, rich and poor, young and old, of every race. Worshipping together, we seek God's love and dare to follow wherever God leads us. Giving of ourselves and our resources, we strive to care for one another and the world beyond our church.

We honor Jesus' imperative: "What you do to the least of these, you do unto me" and "Let not the needy be forgotten, nor the hope of the poor be taken away" (Book of Common Prayer). The mission of the Outreach Committee is to promote the Cathedral's mission "by giving of ourselves and our resources to care for the world beyond Christ Church." To that end, the committee solicits proposals from worthy organizations, carefully reviews and evaluates those proposals and organizations, and recommends to the Vestry grants from the Mission Fund.

In preparing your proposal, the following guidelines are suggested:

1. Projects and institutions in which members of the Cathedral are personally engaged are given priority.
2. Proposals should fall within one or more of the following areas:
 - a. Services to disadvantaged & abused children and youth
 - b. Services that meet basic human needs, health care & housing
 - c. Services to our neighborhood
 - d. Services that promote reconciliation, social justice and advocacy.

In your proposal, please address the following:

1. Describe your project and results to be achieved
2. Discuss your project goals and how they relate to the priorities of the Cathedral Grants program
3. Describe how the project outcomes can be measured
4. List other groups who are also supporting your project or service
5. List any relationship with the Cathedral and members which could strengthen your application
6. If you received a grant from Christ Church Cathedral in the past 3 years, please provide details on how this grant was used to achieve the goals and outcomes stated in that request.
7. Include a financial statement from the previous year, the current year budget, and a list of board members and institution management.
8. Fill out and return Form W-9: Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification.
9. Include your email address to be used for correspondence.
